

Driving to the Penn Cove Water Festival

Coupeville on Whidbey Island

FROM EVERETT, SEATTLE AND POINTS SOUTH

Take the Mukilteo/Clinton Ferry, which runs at 6:00, 7:00 and 8:00 am and then every half hour.

Allow time for an extra ferry or two because this route gets backed up!

Coupeville is 45 minutes from Clinton. From the ferry, drive north on Hwy 525 (which becomes Hwy 20) to Coupeville. Turn right on Main Street (traffic signal with pedestrian bridge over the highway), then straight to the waterfront. Turn left onto Coveland Street, at 4-way intersection volunteers will help find your booth space.

FROM THE NORTH

Take Hwy 20 West (though you are really driving south) over the Deception Pass Bridge.

Coupeville is about 30 minutes from the Bridge. Follow Hwy 20 through Oak Harbor. At intersection after Walgreens where Hwy 20 turns right to head south to Coupeville. This is about 10 miles.

Turn left on Main Street (traffic signal with pedestrian bridge over the highway), then straight to the waterfront. Turn left onto <u>Coveland</u> Street, at the <u>4 way</u> intersection volunteers will help find your booth space.

FROM THE OLYMPIC PENINSULA

Take the Port Townsend/Keystone (Coupeville) Ferry. Coupeville is about 15 minutes from Keystone.

There ARE scheduled low tide cancellations in the morning, but runs have been added from Port

Townsend at 6:55, 8:15 and 9:35 a.m. This route is also subject to wind and current cancellations.

There is no fee for making reservations.

At Keystone, turn left off the ferry (ignore the signage). Follow the main road, which becomes Engle Road and then Main Street (watch 25 mph speed limit in Town!).

Cross the highway and go straight to the waterfront. Turn left onto Coveland Street, at the 4 way intersection volunteers will help find your booth space.
